

DLA LESO Announces 5 Raytheon King Air B300s Coming Available

USSOCOM is declaring 5 each Raytheon King Air B300 excess. Our program is being given an opportunity to screen for any interest. Please note, these aircraft are currently located and being utilized overseas. They will be returned to the United States in October or November 2015 and will be ready approximately January 2016. Where the aircraft will be brought back to and can be picked up by our Law Enforcement Agency is unknown at this time. Access to the aircraft prior to this is not feasible at this time.

Due to the other screening that must be done with aircraft that our program does not accept, there is a short suspense on this data call, therefore we are screening program wide.

I will be using the National Priority List as a guide if several agency are interested and a decision must be made as to the priority of one over another.

For an agency to be considered for one of these aircraft the following must be submitted to our office through your state coordinator:

1. an aircraft request form
2. justification letter (please use attached version of the aircraft request form and justification template since these aircraft will not be deliver until after October 1-changes are made to incorporate the Executive Order)
3. copies of pilots license
4. copy of their aviation SOP
